Dr. Manuel Pastor is currently a Professor of Geography and American Studies & Ethnicity at the University of Southern California where he directs the Program for Environmental and Regional Equity (PERE) at USC's Center for Sustainable Cities.

Dr. Pastor received his Ph.D. in Economics at the University of Massachusetts, Amherst in 1984.

Dr. Pastor's most recent book, co-authored with Chris Benner and Laura Leete, is entitled *Staircases or Treadmills: Labor Market Intermediaries and Economic Opportunity in a Changing Economy* (Russell Sage, 2007). He also co-authored with Peter Dreier, Eugene Grigsby, and Marta Lopez-Garza *Regions That Work: How Cities and Suburbs Can Grow Together* (University of Minnesota Press, 2000), a book that has become a reference for those seeking to better link community and regional development.
